


PROJECTS AND CHARITIES SUPPORTED BY PITTSFORD ROTARY FOUNDATION



DICTIONARY PROJECT	Annual program to provide an encyclopedic dictionary to all Pittsford third graders, both at public and parochial schools, to encourage reading and writing.
CAMP HACCAMO	A specialized camp for handicapped children. Rotary provides for annual cleanup, maintenance, and substantial contributions for camp operations
FISHING DERBY	Every May, in Powder Mills Park, we encourage children to enjoy fishing and the environment.
CUB SCOUTS	We Sponsor Packs 2 and 617. One of this club's original projects dating from 1945
